Colorado Futuretek is a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation and our vision is to help African American and other underrepresented minority students bridge the "Digital Divide".

Our programs help to prepare students for college and for meaningful jobs and careers. We leverage the experience and expertise of engineers, entrepreneurs, and other business professionals to support this effort. We also work to elevate senior citizens by providing basic computer and smartphone training to increase their knowledge and comfort with technology.

During 2022, we continued to enhance our programs for middle school students, high school students, early career young adults, and senior citizens. We provided two STEAM middle school programs including computer training and financial literacy.



Our 6-week SummerTEK program for high school students included the following courses:

- CCNA v7 Introduction to Networks
- Advanced Networks
- Introduction to Cybersecurity
- Introduction to the Internet of Things (IoT)

We facilitated a series of CFTEK Alumni Financial Seminars. We provided two senior citizen computer training programs, Silver Saturdays and Summer SilverTeks. We are continuing to grow our outreach. Our 2022 programs, activities, and financials are summarized in this annual report.



# STEAM F.U.T.U.R.E. 2022



## Saving towards a better future.

STEAM F.U.T.U.R.E. teaches students financial literacy basics through online activities and games, and the opening of a children's savings account—starting them on the right track, early on.

STEAM F.U.T.U.R.E. online classes were first held December 20 - 23 and December 27 – 30, 2021. Topics included goal setting, budgeting, and saving. We continued the program in December 2022.

Students (and parents) learned how to open a child's savings account at Young Americans Bank, and Colorado Futuretek provided each child with a \$10 deposit to open their account.





# Technology and learning that empowers.

SummerTEK is an exciting 6-week opportunity for high school students to explore rewarding careers and to acquire valuable technology skills in a supportive and user-friendly environment.

In 2022, SummerTEK was expanded from a four-course program to offer five valuable courses from June 6 through July 15. Colorado Futuretek and SparqU instructors used Cisco Networking Academy online curricula and LearnKey Entrepreneurship curricula to teach the following courses:

- CCNA v7 Introduction to Networks Students learned how the internet works and how to design computer networks for home and small businesses.
- Advanced Networks Our Advanced Computer Networking course for past SummerTEK students.
- **Introduction to Cybersecurity** Students learned how to protect computer systems from threats, attacks and vulnerabilities.
- Introduction to the Internet of Things (IoT) Students learned how sensors, software, and smart devices can improve the way we work and live.
- Entrepreneurship Students learned business concepts and how to turn an idea into a successful small business.



## The next step towards your future.

The CFTEK Alumni Network consists of young adults who participated in our training and internship programs. It provides valuable information, opportunities, and resources for college and early career young adults.

New in 2021 and 2022, we hosted a series of five, online financial workshops presented by business professionals. The workshops included home ownership, investing, banking services, saving, and budgeting.


# Microsoft Office tutorials with one-on-one help for Seniors.











