


STEAM! SUMMER PROGRAM

JULY 10 - 27, 2023

MIDDLE SCHOOL

Interactive, fun, project-based learning each summer.

Our STEAM! Summer program introduces students in Grades 5-8 to Paint 3D, Minecraft programming, and financial literacy in a fun and interactive way. High school readiness is included for 7th & 8th grade students, putting them ahead of the crowd. In 2023, students built a 3D Birthday Celebration diorama—all from scratch. Students learned the basics of 3-dimensional design in Microsoft Paint 3D, how to use the tools to import, rotate, and place objects along a 3D plane.



Coding basics with Minecraft.

Students got an introductory experience with coding and computer science from Minecraft Hour of Code tutorials at Code.org. These tutorials taught students basic commands, loops, while statements, and do statements. Each student had to overcome obstacles and solve puzzles with code to make it to the end.

STEAM F.U.T.U.R.E.

DECEMBER 2023

First steps toward a bright, growing financial future.



STEAM F.U.T.U.R.E. is all about finance and this year was no different. Students learned the basics of a budget, how to create one, how to set financial goals, the difference between short-term and long term saving, and how to shop responsibly.

Plus, students (and parents) learned how to open a child's savings account at Young Americans Bank, and Colorado Futuretek provided each child with a \$10 deposit to open their account.



SUMMERTEK

JUNE 6 - JULY 15, 2023

Technology & business training. New doors of opportunity.

SummerTEK is our opportunity for high school students to explore rewarding careers and to acquire valuable technology skills in a supportive and user-friendly environment. This year, for the first time, SummerTEK offered the Communication Skills for Business (CSB) Certification Course, allowing students to receive official certification from Certiport (A Pearson VUE Business), the leading provider of certification exam development, delivery, and program management services.

In total, we offered four exciting courses in partnership with SparqU including the following:

- CCNA v7 Introduction to Networks Students learned how the internet works and how to design computer networks for home and small businesses. The course introduced architectures, models, protocols, and networking elements.
- Communication Skills for Business (CSB) Certification Course The core concepts included professional communication skills; effective verbal, nonverbal and listening skills; creating business deliverables; effectively delivering a message; receiving communications; and analyzing communication scenarios.
- **Professional Communication Course** Students learned how to improve their skills in writing, reading, public speaking, active listening, and digital literacy.
- Entrepreneurship The course covered business concepts, financial management, how to recognize a business opportunity, and how to turn an idea into a successful small business.



SENIOR CITIZENS

Microsoft basics for seniors, plus a student guide.

Summer SilverTeks is a 4-week, Monday through Friday course for senior citizens covering Microsoft Office basics. Each senior is provided with a workbook and guidance from CFTEK student tutors. This year, seniors went through the workbook "Teach Yourself Visually Microsoft 365", which covered the transition from older versions of Microsoft Office to Microsoft 365.





SILVER SATURDAYS


SPRING & FALL, 2023

SENIOR CITIZENS

Monthly projects that teach seniors new computer skills.

Silver Saturdays is a project-based class to help senior citizens learn the basics or improve their skills using laptops or smartphones. We teach skills in Microsoft Office and other software. In 2023, seniors learned to create many things including a monthly budget, bill reminder, and a blood pressure chart in Microsoft Excel. They also learned to create an event flyer in Word, animated holiday greeting cards in Powerpoint, and mail merge for email using Word and Excel.

Our student tutors worked one-on-one in Zoom breakout rooms, helping seniors with each project. Seniors also received individual tutoring sessions upon request.









